

Authorization – Passport application for children/ persons under Guardianship

Information

Both parents must give their written consent when they have shared custody of a child under the age of 18 years.

At least one parent must accompany the child to the Police Station/ Foreign Mission and bring his/ hers valid ID.

In the case of joint custody the absent parent must submit:

- a written authorization
- his/ hers original valid ID with a picture and signature, or a certified copy from the issuing authority

The authorization must not be older than three months, and it must be dated and signed by the absent parent.

If the care of the child is provided by the Child Welfare, it is the Child Welfare whom gives their written consent.

For persons that are placed under Guardianship it is the Guardian who will give his/ hers written consent.
